Summer Series

Clay Pigeon Raceway have organised a series or races open to teams of 1,2,3,4 drivers

These will be run on the following dates;

WEDNESDAY 10TH JUNE

WEDNESDAY 15TH JULY

WEDNESDAY 19TH AUGUST

FEE: £110 per team

(Cheques to be made payable to Clay Pigeon Raceway)

We require a £50 deposit with entry forms to guarantee your teams place.

Save yourself money and book all THREE events for £300.

ENTRIES: Will be prioritised to teams who wish to compete in the full series. All teams wishing to do only the one round will be able to enter 2 weeks before the first round. Those teams competing in the first round will be given preference on entries for the second and third rounds, providing their entries are received 7 days before the event.

Due to teams booking into events and not turning up, full payment is due 7 days before event to enable reserve teams to be booked.

AWARDS: Trophies will be awarded to the first to third teams per event.

<u>POINTS TO OVERALL WINTER SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP</u>: 16 points for first, 14 points for second. 12 points for third and so on and so forth. Bonus point for pole position and the fastest RACE lap.

OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP: The winner of the overall championship will be the team scoring the most points over the THREE rounds. A runners up and third place trophy will also be presented.

**Tie breaks will be resolved by the finishing position in the last round.

<u>DRIVER QUALIFICATION</u>: The events are open to drivers over the age 18. However drivers who have reached the age of 16 may compete if their competence to drive can be proved. All drivers will compete on karts supplied by the circuit and each team will draw for their kart at signing on at each event. There will be no selection of karts by any team. Helmets, overalls and gloves will be supplied. However, if you wish to use your own protective equipment you may do so at the discretion of the organisers.

QUALIFYING: Qualifying will be of a 20 minute duration and every member of your team must complete at least 3 laps. During qualifying your lap times will be recorded and the fastest lap time achieved by any of your team drivers will decide your team's starting grid position. The team with the fastest lap time will start on pole, the team with the second fastest qualifying lap will start on grid 2 and so on and so forth.

Any driver overtaking under yellow flags during qualifying will receive a 5 grid place penalty.

RACE: The race will run for 1hr 20 minutes during which the teams must take at least 3 pit stops. The driver strategy will be at the discretion of the team manager. There will be <u>no</u> refuelling stops. The winner will be the team that completes the most laps in 1hr 20 minutes.

NON-MECHANICAL KART CHANGES: Teams have the ability to make 1 non-mechanical kart change during the event, however if a kart change is made going back to the previous kart is usually not allowed but can be changed at the organisers discretion. No non-mechanical kart changes can be made during the first 5 minutes of qualifying.

The organisers will have the right to amend these regulations at short notice but, will inform all teams of there decision.

DRIVERS BRIEFING: All drivers and team managers must attend the drivers briefing.
